Recommendation for Hospitalization

It has been found that you are infected with tuberculosis as stipulated in Article 6 of the Act on the Prevention of Infectious Diseases and Medical Care for Patients with Infectious Diseases (hereinafter referred to as the "Act").

Therefore, pursuant to the provisions of Article 19, Paragraph 1 of the Act (applying mutatis mutandis to Article 26 of the Act), we recommend that you be hospitalized as follows.

If you do not follow this recommendation, measures to hospitalize you may be implemented in accordance with the provisions of Article 19, Paragraph 3 of the Act (applying mutatis mutandis to Article 26 of the Act).

1. Medical institution where you will be hospitalized

You may request to be discharged from the hospital pursuant to the provisions of Article 22, Paragraph 3 of the Act (applying mutatis mutandis to Article 26 of the Act). If it is confirmed that you are not carrying the pathogen of the infectious disease or that the symptoms of the infectious disease have disappeared, the hospitalization will be terminated in accordance with the provisions of Article 22, Paragraph 1 of the Act (applying mutatis mutandis to Article 26 of the Act).

In addition, pursuant to the provisions of Article 24-2, Paragraph 1 of the Act, you may file a complaint in writing or orally about the treatment you receive during your hospitalization.
